Directions: You are going to create a comic strip flip book for an Indian myth or story. To do this, follow the steps listed.

1. Using the link below, pick a myth and read it.

- 2. Then, use the graphic organizer provided to break down the story by summarizing it for each section (beginning, rising action, climax, falling action and conclusion).
- 3. After you have broken the story down, rewrite it in your own words in captions the way you would see on a comic strip. You will have two pages for each section of the story (2 for beginning, 2 for rising action, 2 for climax, 2 for falling action, 2 for the resolution.) You should have 2-3 sentences per page. You should have one colored picture per page.
- 4. For the title page, you will draw a picture and use the tissue paper to create a mosaic type picture on the cover.
- 5. For the last page- you should write "The End" and draw a funny picture related to your myth.
