Early Humans Skull Lab

Directions: You will be making a flip book about early humans. Follow the instructions below:

Steps:

- 1. Using the construction paper provided, cut out pages so that they look like a flip book. Watch Mrs. Spaccia's demonstration.
- You must have a title page. Using a skull diagram measure the Australopithecus Boisei for the title page. Give your book a creative title. Make sure you write your name on the front title page.
- 3. On every page, except the last page, you will have to cut and paste the measurement skulls diagram on each page.
- 4. You will measure different angles and the circumference of the skulls and record them on each skulls diagram.
- 5. You will cut and paste the pictures of the early humans and their names and dates from the second handout provided and glue them on the appropriate page for each early human. Follow Mrs. Spaccia's demonstration.

- 6. You will go online and research one fact about each Early Human and write it on the page.
- 7. On the last page, you will draw a picture of yourself, measure and record your skull and record your height and weight on this page. You must also tell me one interesting fact about yourself.
